

The Royal Marsden National Cancer Leadership Programme 2011

This well regarded programme (now in its seventh year) has been developed to focus on the individual needs of cancer professionals.

This is a continuously evolving programme, reflecting the changing political environment, and the personal needs of the participants. This leads to a highly interactive learning experience which uses a range of world renowned tools to measure leadership practices and provide feedback, which will be used to tailor activities within the programme.

Time will be given to the development of the range of strategic leadership skills necessary for cancer professionals, and the application of concepts and theories to the practice of leadership.

The Programme Director and facilitators will use a range of innovative activities, alongside time 'in the classroom', which will also develop strategic team-working and problem solving approaches.

This programme allows participants 'time out' from the workplace, giving them time to adapt concepts and strategies to their own personal circumstances. The schedule is designed to allow free time for reflection, ample time for debate and exchange, networking and groupwork.
